The cost of the LoC (Associate annual membership fee is £97 [Jan-Jun 2022] and £49 [Jul-Dec 2022] plus LoC registration is £80) is the responsibility of the individual/practice/network** Training Option 1 The trainee may go to the Solent Sexual Health Service where they will be provided with practical skills training and certification of completion of the LoC. Contact ellie.birtley@solent.nhs.uk for further guidance and completion of Solent application. Be assigned a trainer: typically this will require 3 sessions. The cost of this training would be £200 payable to Solent. Training Option 2 A Faculty Registered Trainer will come to the practice of the trainee to provide practical skills training and certify completion of the LoC. Typically this will require 2-3 sessions dependent on clinical experience. For this option the trainee practice would need to arrange for 4 x insertion and 4 x removal patients to attend the clinic on the day of training. If you need further clarification in how to set up clinics, please contact your council lead. The training would include dummy arm training and live training. This training is provided free of charge to the trainee as a service to medicine by Organon Ltd in order to maintain and improve patient care. Training Option 1

The trainee may go to the Solent Sexual Health Service where they will be provided with practical skills training and certification of completion of the LoC. Contact ellie.birtley@solent.nhs.uk for further guidance and completion of Solent application. Be assigned a trainer: typically this will require minimum 4 sessions. The cost of this training would be £200 payable to Solent.****

Training Option 2

A Faculty Registered Trainer will come to the practice of the trainee to provide practical skills training and certify completion of the LoC. Bayer will provide 3 sessions (over a maximum of 6 months). For this option the trainee practice would need to arrange for 5-6 suitable patients to attend the clinics on the days of training. The training would include dummy uterus training and live training. This training is provided free of charge to the trainee by a Medical Education Good and Services provided by Bayer Ltd as a service to the NHS to maintain and improve patient care.

Recertification of the LoC IUT will be required every 5 years. However to maintain LoC certified, you must fit 12 coils covering a consecutive 12 month period within 24 months of the recertification date****
